

What is MDCAT?



The Medical & Dental Colleges Admission Test (MDCAT) is a mandatory, standardized test for MBBS and BDS admissions in all medical and dental institutions, as per PM&DC Act, 2022, Section 17(2).

- Test duration: 3.5 hours (210 minutes)
- Reporting Time: 08:00 hrs PST.
- Exam Time ; 10:00 AM Till 01:30 PM (PST)
- Format: Pen and paper-based in English.
- Administered by: Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Medical University (SZABMU)
- Responsible for: Test production, marking, and province-wide test center network
- Format, weightage, and curriculum: As notified by PM&DC


- 1. Visit University website https://admission.szabmu.edu.pk/
- 2. Enter your complete CNIC/Passport/B-Form without dash (-).
- 3. Download and print Admit Card on white, plain, A4 size paper.

Important Notes

- Admit Card is issued provisionally, subject to eligibility fulfillment.
- Candidates must appear at designated center, date, and time.
- No changes are allowed to Admit Card content.
- Verify particulars and photo; report discrepancies to University.
- Admit Card does not guarantee eligibility acceptance.

Test Day Procedures & Regulations

<u>Before the Test</u>

- Verify the test center address
- Arrive at the center 2 hours before the test (8:00 a.m.)(PST)
- Bring:
- <u>Original</u>CNIC/NICOP/JC/Passport/(for 18 years age& above)
- <u>Original</u> B-Form/FRC issued by NADRA/Juvenile card(JV)(less than 18 years age)
- <u>Original</u>SSC/Matriculation transcripts/certificates with photographs
 - Admit Card printout
 - Transparent clipboard
- 2 blue & black ballpoint pens (Pointter/Gell Pen/Ink Pen /Marker not allowed)

<u>During the Test</u>

- Search and check by Supervisory Staff
- Invigilator will verify Admittance Card and sign documents
- Occupy allotted seat; no changes allowed
- No leaving the test center until the test is over
- No using toilet facilities for the first hour
- Hand over response form upper sheet to the invigilator before leaving

Before Attempting the Test

- Read instructions on the Response Form and Question Paper carefully
- Check the Question Paper for any missing or damaged pages
- Report any issues to the invigilator immediately


















<u>How to Fill Roll Number on the Response</u> <u>Form</u>

Roll no. shall be printed on your response form.

Response Form

- Answer the test on the specialized Response Form provided

- Use a blue/black ballpoint pen only
 Do not detach the two sheets of the Response Form
- Do not fold or tear the Response Form

Important Instructions for Marking the Responses

- Use a blue/black ballpoint pen only
- Fill in the appropriate circle completely

- Do not mark answers on the Question Paper

- Do not use eraser or white fluid on the Response Form

<u>Scoring</u>

- Total marks: 200
- Each question carries 1 mark
- No negative marking

- More than one answer indicated against a question will be deemed as incorrect

Rough Work

 Do rough work on the blank pages provided at the end of the Question Paper
 Do not do rough work on the Response Form

At the End of the Test

- Return the upper, colored sheet of the Response Form and the Question Paper to the invigilator

- Take the lower, carbonized sheet with you

- Ensure you have returned the correct documents to avoid disqualification

Breach of Examination Rules





Unfair Means Practices

- Possessing barred items
- Impersonation or preparing material for copying
- Breaching examination rules
- Assisting others in malpractice
- Marking answers on unauthorized materials
- Tearing or removing examination materials
- Communicating with others during the test
- Smuggling out question papers or response forms
- Threatening officials or candidates
- Manipulating documents or photographs
- Forceful entry/exit or leaving without permission
- Providing wrong information
- Creating obstacles in the examination

<u>Barred Items</u>: The following items are not allowed inside the examination center:

- Stationery items (except Admit Card and original documents)
- Communication devices
- Other items like wallets, goggles, handbags, etc.
- Digital watches or smart wrist watches
- Eatable items



Punishment for Using Unfair Means Practice

Candidates found using unfair means will have their examination cancelled
Cases will be dealt with according to the Examination Regulations of the University

- Drop off and pick up your children from their respective centers
